# Implementation of the Public Safety Checklist 2012

#### <u>Background:</u>

The Public Safety Checklist went into effect September 1, 2012. Due to the Labor Day holiday 9/3/12, the automation went into production September 4, 2012.

In November 2009, the Oregon Association of Community Corrections Directors (OACCD) charted a workgroup to study the feasibility of incorporating a new static risk tool to replace the current Oregon Case Management System (OCMS) risk assessment tool. The workgroup was comprised of representatives from county community corrections agencies, the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), and the Department of Corrections (DOC). The workgroup reviewed and piloted a number of tools including the LSI/R SV, LS/CMI Section 1.1, the Oregon Risk Assessment Tool (ORAT), and the Proxy.

Ultimately, the workgroup recommended a tool developed by CJC called the Public Safety Checklist (PSC). The PSC is a revised version of the earlier ORAT. The recommendation was the result of numerous factors including:

- 4 Calculates 15 factors behind the scenes

The workgroup also recognized that the PSC does have some deficits, including lack of juvenile and out of state criminal history and does not access an offender who has no arrest history. In those cases, the workgroup recommended that the Proxy be used.

On July 13, 2011, workgroup members presented this recommendation to the full membership of OACCD. The association unanimously voted to move forward with the PSC as a replacement for the current OCMS risk tool.

#### The Public Safety Checklist (PSC)Information:

The PSC is a second generation actuarial risk tool designed by CJC in cooperation with DOC. The tool provides a quick, objective, validated assessment of the probability an offender will be reconvicted of a felony within three-years of release from prison or a sentence to probation that's based upon historical Oregon data; the offender's age, gender, and criminal history.

The PSC was built using data from over 350,000 Oregon offenders from 1980 to the present. The tool draws data from the Corrections Information System (CIS), the Law Enforcement Data System (LEDS), and the Oregon Judicial Information Network (OJIN). The PSC weighs the following predictive factors and gives a <u>"composite score"</u> for an offender with these characteristics:

Demographic Data

- 📥 Age
- Gender

Criminal History Data

- ♣ age of first arrest (adult arrests only)
- umber of prior arrests for a person, property or other (statutory) type of crime
- $\downarrow$  arrest record in the last five years
- 4 a previous arrest for a domestic violence crime
- **4** a previous theft conviction
- **4** any prior revocations on parole or probation
- **4** any prior incarcerations
- previous probation and supervision record
- multiple custody cycles

On July 11, 2012, the proposed cut-off scores and associated risk levels were brought before the full OACCD membership and unanimously accepted. They are:

- LOW = 0 to .239
- MEDIUM = .240 to .374
- HIGH = .375+

Use of the PSC is governed by the DOC Community Case Management Rule, Division 078. For purposes regarding the use of the automated tool, the following excerpts apply:

- All agencies are required to use Community Case Management (CCM).
- CCM applies to all offenders being supervised or investigated due to a felony conviction and to offenders on diversion and/or deferred sentences.
- New cases, offenders returned from abscond if he/she has been absent from supervision for a period of six months or longer, and offenders released from incarceration due to revocation or upon a new felony conviction must be assessed by the PSC.
- If the offender has no in-state arrest history or an out-of-state criminal history, the Proxy risk tool will be used. This may include incoming Compact cases.
- For offenders with a PSC or Proxy level of Medium or High, the Level of Service/Case Management Inventory (LS/CMI) tool and a case plan will be completed. The LS/CMI is not required on sex offenders who are subject to the Static 99/Static 99R.
- All overrides must be based upon factors identified by one of the following tools:
  - o LS/CMI
  - o Stable
  - o ODARA
  - Policy Override
  - SVDO designation
  - Unavailable status, which includes:
    - CMPO Compacted Out of State
    - In Custody
    - Medical (Hospice, State Hospital, etc.)
    - Residential Treatment
    - Warrant/Abscond

## Updates to the PSC since Implementation (2013-2014)

The following changes were put into effect between 2013 - 2014 unless specifically noted in the individual subsection:

#### DOC Community Case Management Rule, Division 078:

Changes to the Rule as it pertains to the automation excerpted in page 4 above are as follows:

- New cases, offenders returned from abscond if he/she has been absent from supervision for a period of six months or longer, and offenders released from incarceration due to revocation or upon a new felony conviction or whose calculated risk level changes must be assessed by the PSC.
- If the offender has *extensive juvenile criminal history*, no in-state arrest history or an out-ofstate criminal history, the Proxy risk tool will be used. This may include incoming Compact cases.

#### The Use of 'Policy' Overrides:

Recommendation from OACCD Risk Assessment Workgroup 6/19/13, proposed and supported by OACCD Executive Committee 6/20/13, and voted and accepted by OACCD 7/10/13 for the use of the 'Policy' type override.

OACCD decided at their 5/9/13 meeting to <u>not</u> allow the use of 'Policy' to override the calculated assessment based on time needed to do one of the specialized assessments such as the LS/CMI. Rather, the case will be supervised at the calculated level until the specialized assessment has been completed, and then the override can be done if necessary using the appropriate override type.

The OACCD Risk Assessment Workgroup (ORAW) was convened to work on issues that arose with the new tools. One of the issues identified was lack of clear direction for counties on what should constitute a Policy Override. While some counties have established policies they follow, many are using the Policy Override option in the same manners as the old 'PO Discretion' under OCMS. ORAW polled counties on their existing override policies, and was tasked to develop a joint document with OACCD to send out to counties as a guideline.

#### Examples of Acceptable 'Policy' Overrides:

Overrides in general should not be in place for the duration of supervision. Override Up:

- Person to Person Crimes/Weapons: This could include Ballot Measure 11 offenses. Generally, this type of override should not exceed 6 months.
- > Judge/DA Request: Such as dispositional/optional probation cases and Zero Tolerance.
- > Drug/Specialized Court: Such as Stop, Start, Restitution, Mental Health, or VA.
- High Profile: Involving high profile offenders or victims

Override Down:

- Positive Compliance: To reduce an offender's supervision level, substantial compliance must be demonstrated for a period of 6 months from inception of supervision or last sanction. Examples of positive compliance could include:
  - Alcohol and Drug Compliant does not require completion of treatment, but may mean current compliance with treatment, clean UA's, or no community conduct that signals abuse.

- Keeps Office Visits Appointments are kept or rescheduled. Requires little effort to contact the client to have them report.
- No Formal Sanctions 6 month compliance period.
- Compensatory Fine/Restitution Offender is directed to comply with payment if able.
- Community Service Work Does not have to be completed, but has to have been addressed by having made a referral or other clear directive.

#### The New Cut Off Scores (2014):

Because the PSC scores with the current population were scoring higher than was projected by the sample population, the OACCD risk Assessment Committee relooked at the cut off scores. The original projections for the risk levels were:

Original Projections:

- 59% Low
- 28% Medium
- 13% High

The 2013 population:

- 47.4% Low
- 29.8% Medium
- 22.8% High

The issue found was that the original population used included all offenders, including those on outcount status, instead of only those in the funded caseload pool, which excludes all misdemeanors and outcounts except for Compact Out offenders (CMPO). This was presented to OACCD on 11/22/13, where it was approved to change the cut-off scores to bring us back on track with the original projections to:

#### PSC Cut Off Scores 2/25/14

- Low = 0-25
- Medium = 25-42
- High = 42+

This change was put into production on 2/25/14, and new scores were auto-generated on all active offenders. No outcounts were included. This change did rescore the active population back to the original percentages noted above.

Proxy cut off scores remain: LOW = 0 - 2 MED = 3 - 4HI = 5 - 6

#### Other Changes of Note:

- @ 12/9/13 DOC began updating the CJC website for data consistency between it and CIS. Conviction information continues to be pulled from CIS and arrest information from LEDS on a daily basis.
- The LS/CMI Trainers Workgroup confirm that the LS/CMI should be redone within 1 year of the previous assessment if completed in the Community, and within 2 years if completed in the institution. An edit was completed in CIS 2/25/14 not allowing the use of the LS/CMI as an override if the date is not within the aging criteria.
- Requirement removed from OAR for an assessment to be required on offenders returned from Abscond after 6 months. The new OTTO notification system will notify on any offender whose level has changed, once readmitted, regardless of outcount type.
- An assessment can be done on DOC and Local inmates as of 2/25/14, but another will be required after being admitted to supervision to keep the offender in the funded caseload pool.
- There is still a day lag between entry of conviction information in CIS and updating the PSC calculation.
- The PSC Calculation:
  - 5/8/13 Incoming Compact cases excluded from the calculation.
  - As approved by OACCD 7/10/13, the Domestic Violence variable was removed from the PSC calculation 9/16/13 as the OJIN FAPA data was not reliable.
  - $\circ~$  The most severe conviction in the DOC data is used in the PSC calculation. This CAN be a misdemeanor.
  - A DUII <u>arrest</u> is counted in the Person Arrest category, and a DUII <u>conviction</u> is counted in the Statutory Conviction category.
  - Felony cases with Misdemeanor treatment up front (FMP) are excluded from the PSC calculation.

# The PSC Variables Explanation:

- Age Offender's current age
- Age at first arrest Age at first arrest in LEDS
- Gender Male or Female
- **Total person arrests** Count of total person arrests, truncated at 15 The number of arrest incidents involving a person crime (as defined by Criminal Justice Commission Rules) based on offender's arrest history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the number of charges on a single arrest incident. The PSC considers DUII, burglary, and harassment as person arrests.
- **Total person arrests in the last 5 years** Count of total person arrests in the last 5 years, truncated at 15

The number of arrest incidents in the last 5 years involving a person crime (as defined by Criminal Justice Commission Rules) based on offender's arrest history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the number of charges on a single arrest incident. The PSC considers DUII, burglary, and harassment as person arrests.

- **Total property arrests** Count of total property arrests, truncated at 15 The number of arrest incidents involving a property crime under ORS 137.717.2 based on offender's arrest history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the number of charges on a single arrest incident. Crimes such as theft 3 and criminal mischief 3 are not included in 137.717.2, and are counted as statutory arrests
- Total property arrests in the last 5 years Count of total property arrests in the last 5 years, truncated at 15

The number of arrest incidents in the last 5 years involving a property crime under ORS 137.717.2 based on offender's arrest history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the number of charges on a single arrest incident. Crimes such as theft 3 and criminal mischief 3 are not included in 137.717.2, and are counted as statutory arrests

- Total statutory arrests Count of total statutory arrests, truncated at 15
  The number of arrest incidents involving a statutory crime based on offender's arrest
  history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the
  number of charges on a single arrest incident. Probation, parole, and post-prison
  revocation arrests are not included in the PSC count of arrests.
- Total statutory arrests in the last 5 years Count of total statutory arrests in the last 5 years, truncated at 15 The number of arrest incidents in the last 5 years involving a statutory crime based on offender's arrest history in LEDS. Arrest incidents are counted by date of arrest and do not include the number of charges on a single arrest incident. Probation, parole, and post-prison revocation arrests are not included in the PSC count of arrests.
- **Multiple Custody Cycles** Yes or No variable An offender that has two or more custody cycles is considered to have multiple custody cycles. A custody cycle ends when the offender is completely discharged from incarceration and/or supervision (offender completes incarceration, probation and post-prison supervision). If the offender commits a new offense while incarcerated or on supervision, it is still part of the same custody cycle. If the offender has been completely discharged and commits a new offense, a new custody cycle starts.

- Last Sentence Type 0 or 1 variable, 0-last sentence type was probation, 1- last sentence type was prison
- **Prior Incarceration** Yes or No variable Offender has been incarcerated (jail or prison) for a felony sentence and that felony sentence is in the DOC data
- **Prior Theft Conviction** Yes or No variable Offender has been convicted of a prior theft offense (these include 164.055, 164.057, 164.065, 164.075, 164.085, 164.095, 164.125, 164.140, 165.055, 165.074, 165.800)
- Severity Score three digit severity score of most serious conviction in DOC data
- Most Serious Person Conviction Yes or No variable Yes if the most serious conviction in the DOC data is a person offense. If a person offense conviction is included in the DOC data, but it is not the most serious offense, then this variable is 'No'.
- Most Serious Property Conviction Yes or No variable Yes if the most serious conviction in the DOC data is a property offense. If a property offense conviction is included in the DOC data, but it is not the most serious offense, then this variable is 'No'.
- Most Serious Statutory Conviction Yes or No variable Yes if the most serious conviction in the DOC data is a statutory offense. If a statutory offense conviction is included in the DOC data, but it is not the most serious offense, then this variable is 'No'.

For the most serious person conviction, most serious property conviction, and most serious statutory conviction: only one of these variables will be 'Yes' and the other two will be 'No'.

If you would like to view the CJC data that derived the score, press F20=View PSC Data and the Public Safety Checklist for Oregon (CMS346I) screen appears:

- The data presented on this screen is the same as that on the PSC website with the exception of Age at First arrest.
- Note that this field contains the offender's age if you decide, based on the criteria, to run the Proxy.
- This screen also tells you if the PSC data source is based on Felony Convictions (Felony) or Arrest data (Arrest).
- If the score is based on Arrest data, the screen will display the same disclaimer from the PSC website; 'Offender does not show a felony conviction history in Oregon. Due to the limited criminal history, the risk score has less predictability.', but will not display the Multiple Custody Cycles, Prior Incarceration, and Prior Theft Conviction fields.
- Please also note that the PSC data is a compilation of information from LEDS and DOC, and may not necessarily match what is in CIS. This screen is View only.

There is a new column 'R' on the caseload screen. An 'R' will appear in the column next to an offender name if there is a message to view.

OTTO will not send notifications on any offenders who are currently on any outcount status, such as ABSC. Once the offender is admitted from outcount, OTTO will send notifications only IF the risk level has changed. For example, if the offender's risk level was Low when they absconded, and once readmitted to supervision the level is still Low, OTTO will not send a notification requiring a new PSC/Proxy. If the level has changed to Medium or High once readmitted, OTTO will send a notification.

OTTO will scan daily for the following situations in CIS:

- An offender is admitted to supervision from DOC Institution or Local Control (Review type for the first 30 days, then \*Action type after 30 days). **The Review message**

displayed will be Prev XXXX (DOC institution or LC) offender needs Risk Assessment – Admitted 00/00/0000 (the date of admission). Once 30 days has passed from the date of admission, OTTO will send an Action message. The Action message displayed will be 'Risk Assessment required – Admi frm XXXX (DOC institution or LC)over 30 days 00/00/0000 (the date of admission).

- If a change in Risk Level matches any Override Level (\*Action Type Notification). If OTTO determines a new PSC level is available that is the same as the previous assessment's override level (with the exception of an assessment using the Proxy with Reason Codes of OOS, BOTH, or JUVE) a new PSC will be required. #### Important Considerations:

Because Community Corrections rarely deals in real time in CIS, there are a few things to remember. If an offender's admit date is the first of the month, but it is days/weeks before support staff are able to enter the information in CIS for the OTTO notifications that look at admission to a new custody cycle or from DOC or Local control, OTTO cannot begin to notify until the information has been entered. OTTO does look at the admission date, and the 30 days will count down from that date.

Because OTTO runs between 6:00 and 6:30 each morning, notifications will be sent out, if necessary, around that time and an R code will appear on the caseload. If an assessment is done later that day, the R code will remain until the following morning when OTTO runs again.

• Old OCMS cases with overrides: OTTO will only notify on cases that are returned from an outcount IF the risk level has changed. For most of the offenders with old OCMS assessments that return from an outcount, because they were overridden to Limited (a level not included in the PSC), OTTO will see the level change and require a new assessment. However, there will be some where the levels may match a new PSC and OTTO will not notify. Lack of notification from OTTO does not prevent the creation of a new risk assessment. Please remember, for all offenders whose last

assessment was done by OCMS, to do a new risk assessment when admitting back to supervision whether OTTO notifies you or not.

• Sanctions on Abscond offenders. Although the Structured Sanction Rule is under review, currently it requires offenders who have absconded to be sanctioned at the risk level they were at when they absconded. There are two work-arounds for this: 1) In the automated structured sanction program you can change the risk level to the previous level IF you supply all the dates, i.e. decision date, custody being and end dates, etc. and/or 2) Create the sanction before you do the new risk assessment.
